

## Tarapur Station Director bags International Excellence Award.

Mr. Shashi Bhattacharya, Station Director, Tarapur Atomic Power Station, Units-1&2 of Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited was at No. 1 in the list of nuclear excellence award recipients by World Association of Nuclear Operators (WANO). WANO acknowledge the outstanding contributions made by eight nuclear professionals to promote excellence in safe operation of commercial nuclear power reactors. WANO was formed in 1989 to improve safety of every nuclear power plant in the world.
